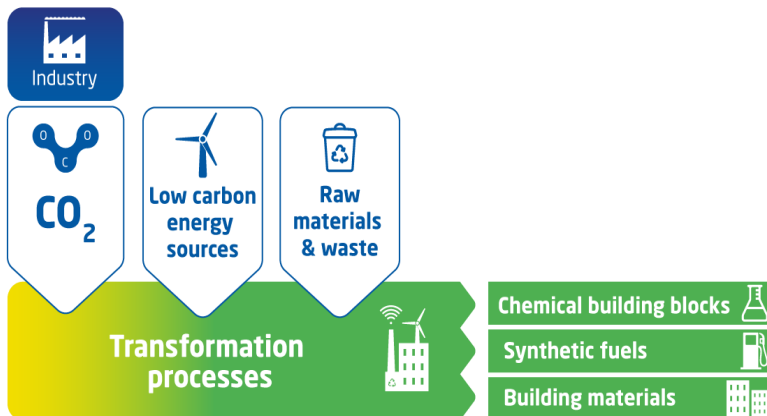


# Join the new European Association on CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation

The purpose of the Association is to **coordinate** the many different players involved in CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation in Europe, to **integrate** their efforts **along the value chain** and to become the **ambassador** of the CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation community towards policy makers and funders.

## What is CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation?

CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation is a broad term that covers all industrial processes that can transform CO<sub>2</sub> into a variety of valuable products such as chemical building blocks, synthetic fuels and building materials.



### OUR VISION

*We believe that CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation can be one of the major growth areas in Europe's future low carbon economy by:*

- *Offering solutions to reduce the carbon footprint of hard-to-decarbonize sectors such as energy-intensive process industries or transportation;*
- *Storing CO<sub>2</sub> permanently in building materials produced by carbonation of mineral waste;*
- *Offering energy storage options which can facilitate the transition of EU energy systems;*
- *Providing revenues to fund the upscaling of carbon capture & storage (CCS) projects.*

### OUR MISSION

*Promote the development and market deployment of sustainable industrial solutions that convert CO<sub>2</sub> into valuable products, in order to contribute to the net reduction of global CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and to the diversification of the feedstock base.*

## Who is behind the creation of the Association?

In 2013-2016, the H2020 **Smart CO<sub>2</sub> Transformation** (SCOT) project demonstrated that the development of CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation can bring **significant benefits for Europe** and its industry. It also concluded that **coordinated collective action** is essential to accelerate its market development.

Building on the strong enthusiasm generated during the SCOT project, the creation of CO<sub>2</sub> Value Europe was prepared in the first half of 2017 by an exceptional consortium composed of the following 29 partners.



**Membership is now open**  
to all organisations interested in the development of CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation.

## Membership fees

- **Full membership** is open to large industrial companies, SMEs and research organisations with manufacturing and/or research activities in Europe
- **Associate membership** is open to research organisations, universities, regional/national clusters, port authorities, collective associations and investors.

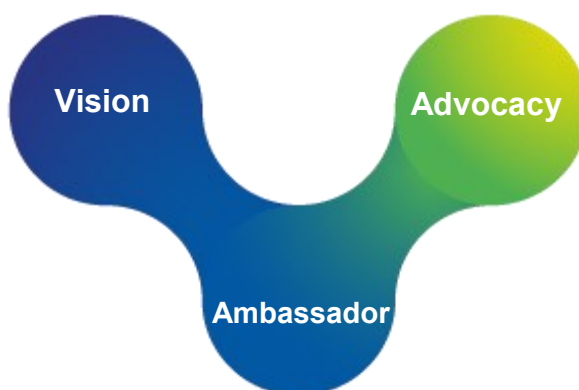

## 3 Strategic objectives

Develop an ambitious and **integrated vision** for CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation in Europe, drive the preparation of a common **R&I roadmap** with all relevant stakeholders, implement this roadmap with existing **public-private partnerships** (PPPs) such as SPIRE, BBI and Fuel Cells & Hydrogen, and facilitate the emergence of multi-stakeholder **pilot and demonstration projects**.



Promote the development of appropriate **regulatory framework and market conditions**, through documented position papers and coordinated advocacy actions with other industry associations. Stimulate also increased **public support for R&I** by European Institutions and Member States.

Raise **awareness** and **acceptance** of CO<sub>2</sub> Utilisation among policy makers, opinion leaders and funders.
